Request for Atlanta Police Liability Insurance & Car Insurance Details By 8th August 2025

Dear Sergeant T. Williams,

Thank you for clarifying why all evidence is being withheld from me. I do have the medically documented disability of "Amnesiac Disorder" and it is the reason I use a video camera to assist with my recall of past events. Your case file contains audio, video and written information that I need to ensure that I can fill in the gaps in my memory and accurately document the incident. Can it be released under the disability laws?

Atlanta Airport Evidence Inventory List

This is the evidence list that Steven Magee, Author of Altitude AIDS, expected the Atlanta Police Department in the Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport to preserve when he filed a police complaint and requested the case file from them in the weeks after the November 15th 2024 police harassment, assault, theft, heatstroke by locking him into a hot car on a sunny day, car crash, denial of medical treatment and long term injury of him:

Start of event:

1. Phone calls and/or texts to police and each other from Frontier Airlines D3 gate staff.

Police officer body cameras from Alaska Airlines/Frontier Airlines shared Gate D3:

1. Kaleem Gibson #4422.

2. Elbert Beasley #4694.

3. Unknown White Male Officer.

4. Police Supervisor C. Kornbacher 6237.

5. Airport surveillance cameras from gate D3 area.

6. Phone calls and texts that Alaska Airlines and Frontier Airlines staff made during and after the incident.

7. Radio calls, phone calls and texts from police officers.

Car transport from Gate D3 to Airport police station:

1. Kaleem Gibson #4422 police car camera. License plate unknown. This video shows the excessive heat assault of Steven Magee from being locked into an overheated police car on a sunny day.

2. Kaleem Gibson #4422 body camera. This video shows the excessive heat assault of Steven Magee from an overheated police car on a sunny day.

Other police officers believed to be in the area that are all wearing body cameras and believed to have video camera equipped cars are:

3. Elbert Beasley #4694.

4. Unknown white male officer.

5. Police Supervisor C. Kornbacher 6237. All wearing body cameras and believed to have video camera equipped cars.

6. Police report that details the overheating of Steven Magee in an excessively hot police car on a

sunny day.

Atlanta Airport Police station:

1. Detention cell cameras that show Steven Magee trying to self treat heat stroke by removing his clothes to get naked to cool down and being denied medical treatment for it by numerous police officers in the police station. These cameras show Steven Magee going into delirium from untreated heat stroke over a period of approximately an hour.
 2. Police station cameras showing the officers present and the searches of Steven Magee's personal items and carry on bag.
 3. Police station cameras that show the theft of Steven Magee's black carry on bag and the police corruption research computer hard drive after the bag search.
 4. Police station cameras that show how Kaleem Gibson #4422 obtained \$500 cash to stuff into a handcuffed Steven Magee's trouser pocket.
- 4 police officers wearing body cameras come into the detention cell to transfer him to the Clayton County Jail instead of the Hospital:

5. Kaleem Gibson #4422 body camera.
6. Unknown white male officer #1 body camera.
7. Unknown white male officer #2 body camera.
8. Unknown white male officer #3 body camera.
9. There appeared to be more police officers in the Atlanta Airport Police station that were ignoring Steven Magee banging on the detention cell door, trying to get medical treatment for heat stroke. Their body cameras may have been recording also.
10. Police report that details the refusal of medical treatment to Steven Magee for heat stroke. Transfer to Clayton County Jail by police car that crashes:
 1. Unknown white male officer #1 police car camera. License plate unknown. This video shows them refusing to put Steven Magee's seat belt on in a car that was traveling at approximately a dangerous and potentially fatal 50 MPH, refusing to tell him where his missing black carry on bag was, and crashing the police car into the Clayton County Jail. It also shows Steven Magee increasingly in delirium from untreated heat stroke.
 2. Unknown white male officer #1 body camera.
 3. Clayton County Jail documentation, photos and videos of police car crashing into their facility.
 4. Clayton County Jail admission videos of Steven Magee, showing him only wearing thick thermal winter trousers and boots. He is half naked as he is still having an untreated heat stroke event. The Atlanta Airport Police officers made him put the clothes on when he needed to go to hospital for treatment. Steven Magee wanted to stay naked because he was so hot! The medical heat crisis was still in process when he was taken to jail. Steven Magee's risk assessment at the time was that refusing to put his clothes on may result in a police assault of him by 4 police officers that were going to try and dress him if he tried to stay fully naked. He put the clothes on under duress to try and prevent a police assault of him. This worsened his heat stroke symptoms that were ongoing and untreated.
 5. Car crash police report.

It appears that Atlanta Police Department have six undisclosed items in their file, which seems to be far less than what is on this list. They are currently refusing to release their evidence list and their evidence for review. Atlanta Police Department state: "We were able to identify six video/audio documents."

Steven Magee is wondering why there is far less evidence on their list as compared to his?

Steven Magee's personal evidence list that he collected during the incident is:

1. A fake police report he obtained from the Atlanta Police Department regarding the incident.
2. The police bag tag from Steven Magee's recovered carry on bag that says "Stolen" on it.
3. A continuous legal protection video recording from the point that the police were called by Frontier Airlines staff through to when the battery ran out on the video camera. The video camera did not stop recording when it was stolen from him by a group of toxic and corrupt Atlanta Airport Police officers. It has recorded hours of video because it never stopped recording. It contains:

- Steven Magee telling police officer Kaleem Gibson #4422 numerous times to cool the overheated police car down can be heard.
- Conversations of numerous police officers can be heard in the police station.
- Steven Magee's banging on the door of the detention cell trying to get medical treatment can be heard.
- Police officers querying if they made the right decision in arresting Steven Magee can be heard.
- Many other things can be heard, as it is hours long.
- This personal video recording demonstrates the need to be video recording police officers that are in your presence for legal protection, as it is now the only recording that Steven Magee has of the incident. The Atlanta Police Department appear to have illegally disappeared much of the evidence in this case and wrote a fake police report that does not match the video recording he has!

Steven Magee currently has zero information regarding audio and video from the super toxic and blatantly corrupt Atlanta Airport Police Department. What they do have is a very big secret! There is no transparency in the Atlanta Police Department and it is regarded as one of the most corrupt police departments in the USA with one of the most biologically toxic and dangerous jails in the USA!

Steven Magee has demonstrated complete transparency in this incident by authorizing the full release of the complete police case file to the public and media. He has authorized it to be fully released, fully un-redacted, and showing him completely naked in the Atlanta Airport Police Station detention room being denied medical treatment for life threatening heat stroke by the Atlanta Police Department. He does not like the idea of people seeing him fully naked and having a medical crisis, but is aware that this police incident is far bigger than him. It appears to be the very first documented incident of a police officer locking a person inside of an overheated police car on a sunny day and causing a long term and possibly life-long injury to them. It is a historical event in the timeline of USA history.

You say you have only six evidence items. Whys do you have so little evidence given that this was a police corruption incident involving multiple police officer thefts from the suspect, police assaults of the suspect, denial of medical treatment for injuries inflicted onto the suspect, a car crash involving the suspect, putting cash into a suspect's pocket, and so on?

I do need an inventory list of what you do have and I would like to remind you that willful destruction of evidence against an accused person that can demonstrate that police officer crimes occurred is an illegal activity in the USA. Destruction of evidence that can demonstrate that the falsely accused suspect is innocent is also a crime in the USA.

I am requesting that you make attempts to preserve the information that I believe that you should have on the file, as this is a case involving a group of corrupt police officers inflicting long term health damage onto an Alaska Airlines passenger on their family vacation in Hartsfield–Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

I do need to know the names, officer identity numbers and photographs of each officer. I have repeatedly been requesting this information and no one is supplying it. There were at least several police officers involved in this incident. Can you supply this information to me or get someone who can do so? I understand that withholding police officer identity from a suspect they have interacted with is an illegal activity.

I am also waiting for the police car insurance information needed for filing an insurance claim. This typically is:

- Police report of each car injury incident.
- All police audio, video, and written information regarding each car injury.
- Your full car insurance policy information for each car that details all coverages for an injured passenger.
- A copy of your police department's liability insurance that details the coverages for a police officer assault with two police cars on a suspect that causes long term health issues that may be life long injuries.

I look forward to receiving the requested information by 8th August 2025 (This week). I will start filing police and FBI crime reports detailing the illegal activity of the Atlanta Police Department's withholding of car injury information at the weekend if I have not received this information from you. You are currently engaging in illegal activity by withholding car crash information needed to file a car insurance injury claim.
