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Dear Police Chief Darin Schierbaum,

I was involved in two police car incidents at the Hartsfield–Jackson Atlanta International Airport on November 15th 2024 where I was on my vacation and heading home with Alaska Airlines from gate D3 to Portland. I now need to request the information from you regarding the two car incidents. I have tried to obtain this from an information request I made to the Atlanta Police Department back in 2024 and so far I have received zero information from them. Can you look into why they are withholding the case file from me that they said I could have?

The information I need for both crashes is everything needed to file a car insurance claim:

- Must exchange contact information.
- Car insurance policy details including coverage limits for car passenger injuries.
- Vehicle information.
- Police reports detailing car incidents.
- All video recordings that detail the car incidents.
- All photographs of the car incidents.
- All records you have that detail the car incidents and my injuries.
- Anything else you have that would be useful to the insurance company.

I was not given this information by either police officer at the time the car injuries were received.

As such, given that I currently have no information from the police officers or the information request, I now need to request the information from you.

1. Assault with an Atlanta Airport police car:

This was an excessive heat assault that occurred in the area of gate D3. I was locked into an excessively hot police car on a hot and sunny day by officer Kaleem Gibson #4422. He refused to cool the car down, locked me into it and left the car. During that time I excessively overheated in the car that had been sitting in full sunlight at midday. This triggered what I initially thought was heat stroke. I communicated this to the police officers involved and they refused all forms of medical treatment for it. I could not even get drinking water to re-hydrate. I was locked into the detention cell at Atlanta Airport police station for approximately an hour where I did the only treatment that was available in there for heatstroke and that was to remove my clothes and get completely naked to try and cool down. Unfortunately, that was not sufficient and I have now identified long term health damage from that denial of medical treatment that I needed. I believe that this car incident occurred around 2pm in a car that was equipped with a video camera and the police officer had a body camera.

2. Car Crash

Instead of giving me drinking water, calling an ambulance or taking me to the hospital as I requested, the Atlanta Airport Police took me to the Clayton County Jail. Before I left the police station Kaleem Gibson #4422 stuffed \$500 cash into my trouser pocket while I was handcuffed. The silent and very fat police officer who transported me refused to put my seat belt on. I do not know who the police officer was, as he did not identify himself to me. In this car I noticed my carry on bag had been stolen by the police officers containing my hard drive that has my police corruption research on it. The police officer

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driving stayed silent when I asked him where it was. The car was traveling at 50 MPH at times, a speed that could cause significant injury or even death without a seat belt if the car crashed. Upon arrival to the jail, something very large and very heavy at the jail smashed into the car, causing a huge bang and huge shockwave to go through the car! The jail staff came out and a large group of jail staff were looking at the accident that had occurred, so they probably have documentation, video and photographs also regarding this car crash. I believe that this car incident occurred around 4pm in a police car that was equipped with a video camera and the police officer had a body camera. I was unable to access the prison hospital for treatment during the 2 nights and 3 days I spent there in a sickly state. After release, I reported the theft of the stolen carry on bag to the Atlanta Police Department for investigation. I never heard anything back from them and I assume none of the thieving police officers was prosecuted for the theft of it.

I am still refining the level and type of long term injury the two car crashes and denial of medical treatment caused, but I am at the point where I can talk to the insurance company about it and tell them the type of life long injury it probably is.

I appreciate your assistance in obtaining this information for me. I would like to get the insurance claims on both cars started and I would appreciate the information by 8th August 2025.
